

## **GCCC Trophy Qualification**

### **Greenhorn trophy**

- Awarded to the boat attending the most rallies.
- One point is awarded for each rally attended.
- Must be a club boat with a club member as skipper.
- Only rallies that are on the programme count, alternative venues allowed only if there is an official change of venue notified by the leader for the rally.
- In the event of a tie on points, the boat with the shortest waterline length wins

### **Stowaway trophy**

Intent – To encourage people into sailing, build experience on a range of boats and offer sailing opportunities for those without boats.

- Awarded to the person who attends the most rallies as a stowaway.
- One point awarded to an individual club member who attends a rally on a club boat and stays overnight on a club boat at the rally.
- In the event of a tie on points, the person who has been on the most different boats as a stowaway wins.
- Skippers and regular crew can be stowaways on another club boat.

### **Welcome aboard trophy**

Intent – To encourage club members to take stowaways on club rallies.

- Awarded to the boat that attends the most rallies with a stowaway.
- One point awarded per rally to the boat that takes one or more stowaways to a rally.
- In the event of a tie on points, the boat with the shortest waterline length wins

Notes: It is unlikely that a person could win the Greenhorn and Stowaway trophy in the same season. However, somebody could conceivably win the Greenhorn and the Welcome Aboard trophy.
